

Film aims to stimulate interest in science

TG4 will next weekend broadcast *The Resistors*, an animated feature film, which it is hoped will stimulate an interest in science among children aged 8-12.

The film was produced by educational media company Metadigita Ltd and the animation was created by Rumble Studios.

The project was funded by Centre for Telecommunications Value-Chain Research, a Science Foundation Ireland initiative, which has a remit to run a schools outreach programme to encourage more students to take science and technology courses.

The show was first broadcast as a series last year. This time, however, it is being shown in its entirety to coincide with Science Week.

The Resistors will be broadcast at 4.15pm on Saturday, November 17th, on TG4.
